ISASP Testing: Please Read!

The Iowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP's) will take place beginning Tuesday, April 20. The schedule is below.

Parents, once an assessment begins in a classroom, we cannot disturb the room unless there is an emergency. Please take note of the times that your child will be testing, and avoid scheduling appointments during those times. You will be asked to wait until the session is over if you come to pick them up in the middle of a test.

If we are notified prior to testing that your student will need to leave during an exam, he/she will need to wait in the office until check-out time, and then will have to make up the test at a later time. We want to avoid this as much as possible; schedules have to be adjusted and it can add unnecessary stress to the students when they are pulled out of class for the exam.
