### **Student Classroom Placement for 2023-2024**

<u>Assigning Students to Classrooms</u> - Elementary teachers will soon begin assigning students to classrooms for next school year. Students will be assigned to classes for next school year by their current teachers and administrator, who are in the best position to make these recommendations. The teachers have worked with the children throughout the year and are able to identify their strengths and areas of needed support. Teachers consider many factors as balanced classes are prepared. These factors include:

- -academic abilities
- -social skills
- -gender balance
- -individual learning styles and needs
- -student personality and interactions
- -combinations of students to avoid
- -class size

**The Goal of the Classroom Assignment Process** - The goal of the class assignment process is to produce a diverse combination of student groups who will work well together in the academic setting. This important task is vital to the creation of a positive class environment, which enables students to function to the best of their abilities. Students are assigned to classes based upon the best possible match of teaching skills and interpersonal needs of students.

<u>Parent Input – We Need Your Support and Input!</u> - Parents who feel the need to provide input about their child's placement should contact the building administrator and request the Elementary Parent Input form from the school office. It is important to note that a request for a specific teacher is not appropriate. When providing input, please share your child's strengths or weaknesses in writing to the administrator. The information will be considered during the class placement process. However, the act of submitting written information or a request does not guarantee placement in a particular class.

Please respect the teachers' and administrator's professional judgment. It is important to note that the teachers and administrator hand place every child. We have each student's best interests in mind as class selections are made. Please have your input into the school by Friday, May 5, 2023.

Thank you, thank you, thank you to all who volunteered, attended, and purchased books and products from the Literati Book Fair at Irving! It was a HUGE success - record-breaking sales! There were 912 books, 88 journals, 125 posters, and 349 school supplies (pens, pencils, erasers, bookmarks) purchased. Our total revenue was over \$10,000 which included in-person sales, online sales, and book club memberships! We earn 30% of that to purchase more books for our library. We were able to buy 20 hardcover books from the Book Fair to add to our library. We will then use the remaining money to order books for the library. If you ordered books online or had paid orders, the books have been delivered to Irving students. Thank you to Jenna Darsee for having the Art Show and our Irving PTO for having the Lemonade and Cookie sale in conjunction with the Book Fair. Thank you all again for supporting reading and our school library!
