Student Drop-off and Pick-up Reminders

Notes from the Transportation Department - 515-961-9592

- All bus students are expected to wear their seat belt during their bus route. If your child is having trouble with the seat belt, please ask the bus driver for help.
- The middle school is a transfer point only for before and after school. Parents should be dropping off and picking up their children at their attendance center if they have plans other than their typical bussing needs.
- According to the Student Transportation Handbook (found on the Indianola website): ' . . . Elementary parents cannot pick up or drop off elementary students at the Middle School for transportation.'
