Entering and Exiting the Building:

Students will enter the building by grade level and at staggered times.

- Kindergarten, 2nd and 4th grades will enter/exit through the southwest doors.
- 1st grade will enter/exit through the main entrance.
- 3rd and 5th grades will enter/exit through the north door.



Notes from the Transportation Department:

No bus passes will be issued starting this school year due to buses being at full capacity and each student has an assigned seat; for example, no passes for birthday parties, going home with friends, etc.

The **only exception** would be if a student is from a split family and must ride to the other parent's address.

The middle school is a transfer point **only** for before and after school. Parents should be dropping off and picking up their children at their attendance center if they have plans other than their typical bussing needs.

According to the Student Transportation Handbook (found on the Indianola website): '. . . Elementary parents cannot pick up or drop off elementary students at the Middle School for transportation.'

Guidelines for Indoor Recess:

If the temperature and/or feels-like temperature is 10° or less, students stay inside for recess.
