Guidelines for Indoor Recess:

If the temperature and/or feels-like temperature is 10° or below or 100° and above, students stay inside for recess.

Students will also come into the building starting at 7:30 in the morning.

Cell Phones/Electronic Communication Devices

Students may possess a cellular telephone or other electronic communication devices (ECD) in school and at school related functions provided that **during** school hours and on school vehicles the cell phone or ECD is powered off, concealed and not in use.

<u>Students are prohibited from using a cell phone or</u> <u>having it powered on during the school day.</u>



Notes from the Transportation Department:

All bus students are expected to wear their seat belt during their bus route. If you child is having trouble with the seat belt, please ask the bus driver for help.

The middle school is a transfer point **only** for before and after school. Parents should be dropping off and picking up their children at their attendance center if they have plans other than their typical bussing needs.

According to the Student Transportation Handbook (found on the Indianola website): *'. . . Elementary* parents cannot pick up or drop off elementary students at the Middle School for transportation.'
