During the school day the main entrance to Laura Ingalls Wilder will be the only entrance and exit for visitors. Once a visitor is "buzzed" into our office area they will need to receive a visitor's badge through our Raptor System. In order to receive a badge, visitors must present a valid driver's license. The Raptor System screens visitors through custom databases while also allowing us to communicate with law enforcement in the event of an emergency. Upon exiting, each visitor must check out with the building secretary by turning in their badge.

Due to the need for increased school security in our Nation we are asking all parents and guardians to check into the office in the morning to receive your visitor badge if you are wishing to walk your child down to the classroom. This will be a requirement beginning on **August 25th** in order for a two day transition opportunity for both students and parents.

Lastly, in the event of an emergency it is imperative that student's emergency contact information is up to date. Any changes to emergency contact information needs to be emailed to enrollment@indianola.k12.ia.us.
