

WHAT IS THE DISTINGUISHED ACHIEVEMENT AWARD?

In support of the Indianola Community School's belief that we will meet the needs of all students so that they can learn at high levels and be prepared for next steps along the way, a Distinguished Achievement Award was developed in 2015-2016 to recognize students that strive to take advantage of the opportunities, activities, and resources available to them. Students who intend to work toward this award complete an Intent to Participate form and return it to Mrs. Ellis, the principal, or Mrs. Asell, the GT teacher, by **Friday, September 30, 2022.**

Students will submit evidence of their achievements through their school Google account in a folder that will be copied during a help session. The portfolio due date is **April 14, 2023.** The portfolios will be scored by either an administrator and/or teacher(s) using scoring rubrics. Pictures and recordings can be included. Students meeting the criteria will be awarded the Indianola Middle School Distinguished Achievement Award at a special ceremony in May in the cafeteria.

Students may submit a portfolio each year of middle school as long as the portfolio contains original work each submission.
