All Warren County youth grades K-12 are eligible to enter the contest. Contestants will compete in three categories K-4 (Sprouts), 5-8 (Growers), and 9-12 (Green Thumbs). Prizes of \$35, \$25, and \$15 will be mailed to the top three contestants in each category.

Our hope is that the contest will be fun for kids and encourage young people to grow other plants and vegetables, develop gardening skills, and become interested in environmental issues and community beautification projects.

Judging takes place on Wednesday July 24 from 10:00 a.m.-Noon. Winners will be announced at 1:00 p.m. Pictures will be taken of all exhibitors with their containers, as well as the winners. If this is a problem, please mention it when checking in.

Judges will base their scores on the following criteria, using a scoring system of 1-5 points for each of the 5 areas:

- Creativity & Overall Design
- Plant Care & Maintenance
- Use of Variety of Plants

- Container Originality & Quality
- Compatibility of Plants to each other

The Ackworth Garden Club will be hosting a **FREE gardening class on Monday, May 6 from 6:00-7:30 p.m.** at the Warren County Extension Office in Indianola 909 East 2nd Avenue, Suite E (Hwy 92) to demonstrate container gardening.
