PROM: The 2021 Indianola High School Prom "Roaring 20s" will be held on Saturday, April 17th at Adventureland's Palace Theatre from 8:00-11:00 pm. with doors opening at 7:30 pm. Masks will be required for all students/guests. The dance is closed to the public.

GRAND MARCH: Prior to Prom, we will hold a Grand March in the high school north gym from 4:30-6:00 pm. Attendees that choose to participate may come and go at any time during this event. IT IS NOT REQUIRED. This event is free to the public and masks are required. Family/friends that wish to observe will enter at the north gym doors and be seated in the West bleachers. Attendees will use the gates by the tennis courts and enter the gym on the north side. Signs will be posted. It is a tradition where students and their dates are introduced to the public prior to the dance. The prom attendees will parade across the gym floor in a lighted pathway to the center spotlight. In the past, this event was held at the Palace Theatre, but moved this year to accommodate the public due to covid.
