GENERAL INFORMATION:

- ➤ **FOOD PANTRY:** The HS food pantry will be open on Tuesday, January 5 from 3:30-5:00 pm. Please enter at the south entrance by the flag pole.
- Reminder, if your student will be absent for more than 2 days due to a vacation or being out of town, they must grab a Student Absentee Form (available outside the main office) and have their teachers sign off prior to being gone.
- MASKS: Students, we are seeing a large volume of you that are continually forgetting your masks and asking for a paper mask when you arrive at school. Masks have been a requirement since the first day of school so this isn't something new that we just sprung on you. Some ideas on where you can keep your mask.... in your computer case; near your phone and keys; in your car; in your backpack and always have a spare!

Parents will be notified by the office if your student is repeatedly noncompliant with a mask. No student will be sent home without prior parent contact.

- ➤ HOME QUARANTINE: If your child is home due to a quarantine, they are not allowed to be on campus or participate in any extracurricular activities. This also includes picking up homework or coming in for a club meeting. When a student is in a home quarantine and comes to school, this increases the likelihood of spreading the virus.
- ➤ Clarifications Relating to Covid-19:

Remote Learning—Students who have elected to learn remotely have been asked to make a long term commitment in doing so (at least 2 weeks). Students who have tested positive for Covid-19 or have been in direct contact with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19 and are in quarantine will be expected to remote learn.

Absent Due to Illness—Students who are absent from school because of an illness unrelated to Covid-19, will continue to be onsite learners and follow the makeup policies in the student handbook. Students are encouraged to view PowerSchool class pages to see what they have missed and may begin to complete assignments before returning. However, they will not become remote learners during the time of their illness.

Direct Contact/Positive Test—Students who have been in direct contact with someone who has test positive for Covid-19 or have tested positive themselves need to contact the high school student health office ASAP. Once notified, the administrative office will contact teachers and let them know that the student will be learning remotely and the date he/she is expected to return to onsite learning.

➤ RETURNING TO ON SITE INSTRUCTION: Parents, you must contact the school prior to your student returning to on site instruction. We ask that you either call 961-9500 ext. 2100 or email the principal, jeff.siebersma@indianola.k12.ia.us at a minimum of two days before you would like to make the change.
