PARKING ILLEGALLY: Yes, we know it's cold outside and you don't want to walk far, BUT you are still not allowed to park in the yellow lines in the parking lot. This causes several issues. We have let it go the last couple of days, but we are seeing more violations. Plan ahead and leave earlier from home, wear a coat and hat and you will be able to find a wonderful parking spot with a short jaunt to the attendance office.

If this continues we will begin handing out violations/tickets. It states on the parking/driving registration form you filled out: "If a student is parked illegally anywhere on school grounds, the student will be issued a \$5 ticket for the first offense. On the second offense the student will be issued a \$10 ticket. The ticket will need to be paid in the main office. A third offense will result in the vehicle being towed immediately at the owner's expense."

- 1. Click on the link above to access the Parent/Teacher Scheduling program.
- 2. Create your own personal registration by completing the information on the right hand side of the screen under "REGISTRATION," click here to "LOG IN."
- 3. Add/Edit children and choose the school "Indianola High School. This is important for Freshman parents as your student is still listed under "Indianola Middle School Schedule.
- 4. Select Conference Date.
- 5. Choose your student's teachers, click submit at the bottom.
- 6. Pick your student's Zoom conference time. It will either accept your time or deny it.
- 7. Click Home.
- 8. Click Schedule Conferences.
