GENERAL INFORMATION:

NO FOOD ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING: Outside food is still not allowed in the building during the day unless it is your lunch that you brought from home to eat in the lunchroom. Deliveries from businesses or Apps (i.e. Grub Hub) are also not acceptable. We implemented this restriction at the beginning of the school year, posted signs at the attendance doors and put in the daily announcements. We are starting to see more food brought in after students return from lunch and wanted to reiterate that we have not changed our expectations.

PARKING: Once again we are having issues with parking in the yellow lines. I am confident that your drivers education teachers taught you that it is not legal. We will continue to monitor the lot and initially have you move your vehicle with a warning. We will start handing out tickets if you habitually are called in to move your vehicle and can revoke your parking privileges.

Parking in the lines causes a blind spot to traffic and clogs up the aisles with little room to navigate which can lead to accidents. Be a respectful, responsible driver.

MANY cars are STILL NOT registered. Cars must be registered to park in the lots. The form can be found outside the main office or down in the "Parents" section of the announcements.
