PROM: The 2023 Indianola High School Prom "Under The Stars" will be held on **Saturday, April 22nd at Adventureland's Palace Theatre from 8:00 - 11:00 p.m.** with doors opening at 7:30 p.m. Doors will close at 9:00 p.m. and the dance is closed to the public. **ATTENDEES MUST HAVE THEIR TICKET TO ENTER PROM. A concession stand will be available for attendees to purchase drinks and snacks; must use a debit/credit card to purchase.**

GRAND MARCH: Prior to Prom, we will hold our annual community event, The Grand March, in the high school north gym from 4:30-5:30 p.m. Attendees that choose to participate may come and go at any time during this event. **IT IS NOT REQUIRED BUT ENCOURAGED.** This event is free to the public. Family/friends that wish to observe will enter at the north gym doors and be seated in the west side bleachers. Attendees will use the gates by the tennis courts and enter the gym on the north side. Signs will be posted. It is a tradition where students and their guests are introduced to the public prior to the dance. The prom attendees will parade across the gym floor in a lighted pathway to the magical center spotlight. You are welcome to take pictures inside the gym at your seats, in the hallway where there will be a hedge wall available to take additional photos.

ITD Student Board Positions:

- President = the student chair of Indianola Theatre Department, supervises all fundraising activities efforts, is an automatic official member of all committees, sees that all communications with others are presented properly, and delegate other tasks as needed within reason. Must be an inducted Thespian & served on the board previously.
- Vice-President = coordinates the committees, and organizes and coordinates all social activities and fundraisers. Must be an inducted Thespian.
- Secretary = records, reports, and posts the minutes at each meeting, takes roll call, keeps a complete and current list of members.
- Parliamentarian = sees that parliamentary procedure is carried out in the process of all the meetings. The parliamentarian has the authority to take disciplinary action against any members not willing to follow parliamentary procedure.
- Historian = collects and organizes a visual record of Indianola IHS Productions' accomplishments through the use of pictures, videos, programs, etc. Manages the ITD social media account on behalf of the organization.
- Class representatives (sophomore, junior, & senior) = meet with their respective classes and discuss board and Indianola Theatre Department business. Class representatives also serve on the board of the constitution committee.
