From the Attendance Office: There are two ways to inform the school of a tardy/absence/early dismissal. 1) Email (PREFERRED) ihsattendance@indianola.k12.ia.us or 2) Call 515-961-9510 press 1. Please be mindful that the morning hours prior to school starting are very hectic. If you leave a message, it will get handled in a timely manner.

All students use the west entrance doors during the school day. If you have called ahead to dismiss your student, you do not need to come into the building. You will pick them up and drop them off on the west side of the building. Students need to sign in and out any time they are tardy or leaving/returning from an appointment. Failure to do so will result in an unexcused absence until it is rectified.
