GSA will begin meetings Monday, September 25 after school in Mr. Whitaker's room (E314). Hope to see you there!

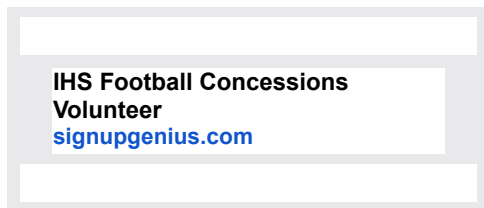
