FROM I.T. DEPARTMENT: As it's a bit chilly outside, please do not leave your district-provided laptop in a vehicle, especially overnight.

- When a cold laptop is brought into a warm room, water may condense on/in the computer if it is colder than the dew point temperature inside the room. Since most people don't typically know what the dew point temperature is in their location, it's important to keep the district-provided laptop in the case/bag until it has had time to "warm up". If water condenses inside of a computer, and it's started up, "bad things" can happen (water + electronics = bad combination).
- In addition to the dew point issue, leaving a computer in cold temperatures can deplete the battery very quickly.
