GIRLS CROSS COUNTRY: The Girls Cross Country team competed at Pickard Park on Wednesday for the 4A State Qualifying Meet. At this meet, the top 3 teams and top 15 individuals qualify for the State Meet on Saturday, October 29th. After running a strong race, the girls ended up 4th, falling to Qualifiers Johnston, Ames, and SEP. Our journey as a full squad has come to an end, BUT we are able to celebrate TWO individual state qualifiers on our team! Congratulations to 12th place finisher, Gracie Foster, and 14th place finisher, Emily Naughton!! Emily ran a season PR of 20:01. We had two other PRs from the night as well. Leah Hartford ran a lifetime PR of 20:29 and Remy Sivertsen ran a season PR of 21:01. Senior Bree Tenges ran one of the best races of her life, placing 16th- just one place off of qualifying- and running a time of 20:08... just 5 seconds shy of a lifetime PR. Also putting in valiant efforts for the Indians were Taylor Hoger, placing 22nd and Jordyn Brown, placing 31st. STay tuned to support Emily and Gracie as they gear up for their final race of the season at the STATE MEET!

BOYS CROSS COUNTRY: Congratulations to the Indianola Boys Cross Country Team on their 5th place finish at the State Qualifying meet on Thursday at Pickard Park! Leading the way for the Indians were freshmen Reed Robbins (23rd), Kiefer Barnes (29th), and Paxton Boom (31st). They were followed by seniors Hunter Seifrig (32nd) and Nathan Epley (34th), junior Sam Ross (36th), and freshman Noah Kjellberg (39th). **It was the end of the season for the Indians, but great things are on the horizon!!**
