- 1. Lifeguard Certification or Lifeguard Training: basic lifeguard certification course, must be 15 years old
- 2. Lifeguard Review or Lifeguard Recert: for those that are already lifeguards and need to get recertified every 2 years.
- 3. WSI: Water Safety Instructor: individual planning to teach swim lessons and be in charge of swim lesson instructors (lesson coordinator)
- 4. Lifeguard Instructor (LGI): Already a lifeguard, 18 years old, and will train lifeguards in basic lifeguarding courses or for weekly lifeguard training.
