Indianola Fall COVID-19 Spectator Guidelines

- 1. Face coverings are strongly recommended, but not mandatory (except for "student sections"), at all Indianola activities.
 - a. Face coverings are highly encouraged in common areas (concession stand line, bathrooms, admission gates, lobby, plaza, etc.)
 - b. Temperature and other health-monitoring measures will not be conducted with spectators. If you are not feeling well or have been exposed to COVID-19, please stay home.
 - c. Individual schools may require additional measures be taken and those will be posted and communicated in advance.
- 2. Bleacher seating will be marked off to reinforce physical distancing seated six feet apart from other groups, unless seated with those they reside with. Every other row of bleachers will be off limits. These areas will be clearly marked.
- 3. A "student section" will be allowed. Students in that section will be required to wear a face covering. Every other row will still be blocked off.
- 4. There will be additional seating at Indianola Stadium on the hill behind the south endzone. You may bring chairs and/or blankets to use in these areas. There is additional concrete space along the fence surrounding the field for individuals to stand.
- 5. Exact change is appreciated for all regular season contests. Prices are below:
 - a. Varsity Football: \$6.00 Adults/\$4.00 Students
 - b. 9th & 10th Football: \$5.00 Adults/\$3.00 Students
 - c. High School Volleyball (All Levels): \$5.00 Adults/\$3.00 Students
 - d. Middle School (Football & Volleyball): \$4.00 Adults/\$2.00 Students
 - e. Change is available if the need arises
- 6. All spectators are encouraged to bring their own hand sanitation and utilize hand washing stations.
- 7. No food or drink should be brought in by spectators.
- 8. There will be no post game gatherings. After the game, all spectators are expected to leave the facility immediately after the event.
