

ICE RINK MOVES TO THE INDIANOLA ACTIVITY CENTER

2204 W. 2ND AVE • (HWY 92 WEST)



This winter, the Indianola Ice Rink will be located in front of the Indianola Activity Center at 2204 W. 2nd Avenue. This is the third season for free skating at the rink, which was donated to the city by the Iowa Wild and Wells Fargo.

Weather permitting, the rink will be open for hockey from dawn to noon, and open skating hours will be from noon to dusk.

The rink will not be supervised; all users will be skating at their own risk, with their own skates. Food, drink, and pets are not allowed on the ice.

Indianola Parks and Recreation staff will maintain the facility. The rink may be periodically closed for maintenance, if there is damage to the rink or if the ice has melted.

A green sign will be posted at the rink to indicate when the rink is open; a red sign will be posted when the rink is closed. Open/closed status will also be posted on the Parks & Recreation Facebook page
