The Simpson College Reading Club offers one-on-one afterschool tutoring services to children in 2nd through 5th grades. This program is for readers who need extra assistance in their skills and strategies. Because of Simpson COVID guidelines, the children will be **required** to wear masks and workspaces will be properly sanitized. Most importantly we are excited to get to work with 2nd through 5th grade students from the Indianola School District!

During the 2021-2022 school year Simpson College reading endorsement students work through two courses; Fall: Assessment and Diagnosis of Reading Difficulties and **Spring: Corrective Reading**. For the Corrective Reading course, Simpson students will tutor children in reading and writing. Below is a bit of basic information about “The Reading Club.”

What: Simpson Reading Club
One-on-one tutoring in reading/writing; prepackaged snacks will be provided

When: Two 1-hour sessions per week on Mondays and Wednesdays 3:20-4:30
January 2022 through April 2022 (minimum of 20 sessions)
(Please note the time remains at 3:20 on Wednesdays even though it is an Early Out Day.)

Where: Dunn Library on Simpson College campus

Who: 2nd through 5th graders **ENROLL BY FRIDAY, JANUARY 14**

Cost: \$25 *(fee waiver upon request)*
